i) **Page 20, clause 17.6 – Non-effective weblink:**

- The HKEIA's website link should be:

ii) **Page 26, Table A.2.4, Note 4 (c)iii :**

- Typo, "1005" should be "100%".

iii) **Page 38, Annex D (The mandated versions of the referred test standards and documents) for IEC 60598-1 :**

- From the IECEE website, the TRF report is not available for IEC 60598-1:2024 (Luminaries – Part 1: General requirements and tests) in conjunction with other IEC 60598-2- standards.
Therefore, CB application using IEC 60598-1:2024 in conjunction with other IEC 60598 part 2 standards is not possible at the moment, and it is not certain when will the application be available.
- Hence, the expiry date for the IEC 60598-1 : 2020 and IEC 60598-1 : 2014 will be deferred to 15 May 2027.

iv) **Page 40, Annex D (The mandated versions of the referred test standards and documents) for LM-80:**

- The change of the LM-80: 2018, LM-80: 2015 and LM-80:2008 to LM-80: 2021 is mainly for the updating of wordings for new LED products and to match the updating of the referred "Nomenclature and Definitions for Illuminating Engineering". The test requirements and procedures remain the same.
- Therefore, it is typical for LED supplier to maintain the same LM-80 test report even there is the updating of the LM-80 versions.
- On the other hand, LEDs for illumination is already a mature technology and this is no foreseeable major changes in coming years.
- Hence, the expiry date for the LM-80: 2018, LM-80: 2015 and LM-80:2008 will be deferred for an additional 3 years to 15 May 2029.

v) **Page 44, Annex E (Revision History) :**

- It states that the transition period of 2 years for updating to the new standard version. According to the issue date of the Scheme which is 06 Mar 2025, the deadline should be 06 Mar 2027. However, in Annex D, it mentioned that the transition period migrating to using updated version will end on 15 May 2026. This is contradictory.
- The end date for the transition to Issue V Rev. 0 should be 15 May 2026.
